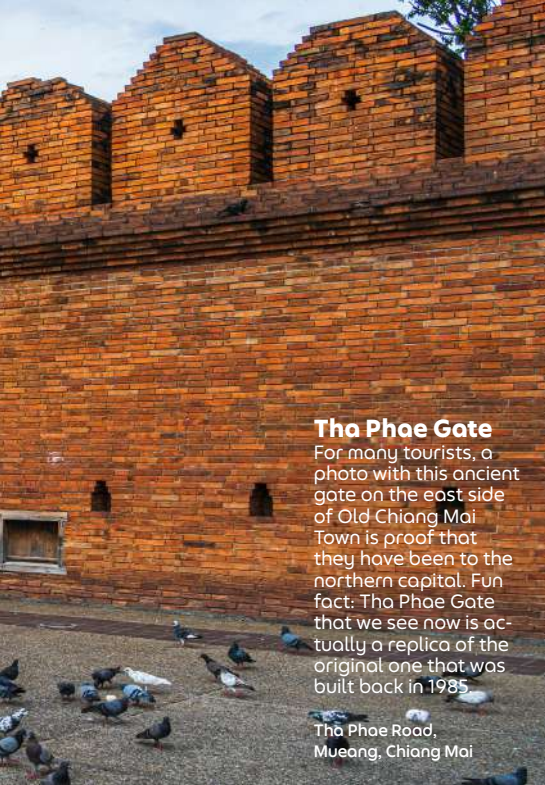
### Angkaew Reservoir
